Community Collaborations International (CCI) will make all the necessary arrangements to provide you and your group with the opportunity to work with a humanitarian or conservation organization in the country for which you register. You agree to volunteer your time and talents to the best of your ability in accordance with CCI guidelines and policies.

CCI is working to assist college and university programs in implementing international volunteer opportunities. The program is collaborating with international humanitarian and conservation organizations with a proven track record managing volunteers. The goal of CCI is to place volunteers where they are needed most and to get the most value out of each volunteer hour. CCI will coordinate with relief providers and all participants will receive safe and sanitary accommodations, three meals per day, and will participate in well organized and safe volunteer projects.

You acknowledge that there are dangers in traveling anywhere. You agree to travel and participate at your own risk. You agree to assume full responsibility for injury to you and damage to your property. You will not sue CCI if, in connection with this Program, you are injured or your property is damaged because of the negligence of CCI or because of the negligence or intentional acts of anyone else. You may sue CCI for intentional acts, gross misconduct or gross negligence.

You agree to follow all applicable rules, policies and guidelines of CCI and the laws of the community in which you serve.
